Events to raise awareness and support mental health with Lifeline Australia

In addition to driving community knowledge of the important work being done by Lifeline, we are also hoping together raise in excess of \$100,000 over the coming year as part of this initiative."

Mr Fitz-Roy said the Expertise Events family recognised the events industry and, in turn, the communities it works with, have been heavily impacted by the pandemic restrictions.

"We understand what our industry has endured over the pandemic. This support of Lifeline Australia isabout using the unique nature of our diverse events to let people of all ages know that Lifeline is there for them 24/7, 365 days of the year. As a family business, collaborating with Lifeline Australia is about being proactive and impactful for the community."

"Over the years, Lifeline has come under increasing pressure for their valuable services to the community and their model relies on sponsorship and donations to help support its operations. I believe the Business Events Industry and communities we work within will rally to help raise the funds and support each other" Mr Fitz-Roy said.

Mr Taktikos said that since the pandemic, daily call rates have increased by 40%, with Lifeline now receiving over 1,000,000 calls per year.

"Events bring people from all walks of life together, so to have the opportunity to collaborate with a forward-thinking organisation like Expertise Events will provide Lifeline with another great platform to educate the community on a grass-roots level, and will also raise vital funds for Lifeline's services.." he said.
